Yee Hong has been accredited by Accreditation Canada since 1994 and has held Exemplary Standing since 2012. Exemplary Standing is the highest level of recognition awarded by Accreditation Canada and reflects an organization’s commitment to excellence and high-quality, person-centred care.

“This achievement reflects the extraordinary dedication of our staff and physicians who provide compassionate, high-quality care to seniors each and every day. It also reflects the support and engagement of our Board members, residents, clients, families, volunteers, partners, and community,” said Glen Chow, Chief Executive Officer, Yee Hong.

Accreditation is a voluntary process that Yee Hong participates in every four years as part of its ongoing commitment to quality improvement and excellence in care and service.

“Accreditation is about continuous quality improvement every day,” said Chow. “The results and feedback from the surveyors will help us continue strengthening quality across Yee Hong and advance the care, programs, and services we provide.”
