We understand the importance of feeling safe and comfortable at home. That's why our clean, bright, and spacious homes are designed with rooms, social spaces, and amenities to create home-like environments. Each home provides residents and their caregivers with access to:

- Higher quality care: Independent assessments rank Yee Hong's quality indicators far above the Ontario average.
- Longer life expectancy: On average, Yee Hong residents live longer than other seniors in Ontario.
- Exceeding Standards: Yee Hong's Quality indicators exceed the Canadian Institute for Health Information (CIHI) benchmarks, and maintains exemplary status by Accreditation Canada, the country's foremost accrediting body.

- 24-hour nursing and personal care, with all-day access to an in-house nurse practitioner and physicians.

- Integrated physical (e.g., Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Music Therapy, Podiatry, Geriatric Psychiatry), spiritual, and Recreational Programs.

Building our Legacy

Demand for high-quality, culturally appropriate beds in Canada is growing. Yee Hong is answering this critical need with plans to build new centres, including a new five-storey, 250,000 sq. ft. facility at our Scarborough campus. Opening in 2026, this facility will feature 224 residential rooms, on-site healthcare professionals and services, maintenance, entertainment, and communication technologies, vibrant resident and community programming spaces, and enriching outdoor spaces.
